

Community Language - Extra GCSE

At Greatfields School, your child has an opportunity to get an extra GCSE.

If your child can read, write, speak and understand any of the following languages, they can be entered for an **extra** GCSE in Year 10 or Year 11:

Arabic, Bangla, Chinese, French, Italian, Japanese, Polish, Portuguese, Punjabi, Russian or Turkish.

Your child will need to prepare for the exams at home but we will provide your child with guidance and past papers to practice in their own time.

Assessment

Three Tracking Assessments each year:

- 1. End of Christmas term
- 2. End of Easter term
- 3. End of summer term (end of year exam)

The assessments are monitoring progress and are not high stakes tests.



Reporting to parents

- ▶ Parents will be sent a report after each Tracking Assessment
- The report will not contain grades or target grades, but will indicate whether or not your child is on track in each subject.



Attendance

- High attendance is absolutely crucial to your child's success in school
- School target is 98%
- ▶ Rewards and badges for 100% attendance
- ▶ If your child is not going to be in school you must ring the school to inform us why they will be absent.
- Any holidays during term time may result in a fine.
